## HELP

For when you need non-emergency assistance.

## FIRST AID

If you or others need medical assistance.

## EMERGENCY

If you or others need urgent assistance.

## WELLBEING ASSISTANCE

Provides you with relevant support information.





## Safer Community Team

The team has a strong focus on the wellbeing and welfare of the campus community providing 24/7 advice, assistance & support.

### Triage

- Connect individuals with appropriate resources on/off campus.
- Mental Health, DV, Sexual Misconduct, Harassment.

### Court Advocacy

- Restraining orders
- Support in court

### Crisis Accommodation

- Domestic violence and sexual misconduct
- Homeless concerns - out of hours

### Assignment Deferral

- Only in cases of sexual misconduct

### Welfare Checks

- On & off campus welfare checks Staff/Students



**Safer Community Team offer a range of security services including..**

**Monitoring:**

- 24/7 Control Room
- 3,000 CCTV Cameras, all WA campuses

**Patrols**

- Foot, bicycle & vehicle
- Officer nightly in Exchange

**Response:**

- First Aid & Fire Alarm
- Incident Investigation

**Key & Access Control:**

- Contractor ID Cards
- Key and Lock ordering

**Road Closure:**

- Approval and road barricade setup

**Mechanical Assistance:**

- Battery jump start
- Vehicle unlocking
- Assistance with tyre puncture

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## First aid fact sheet

# Fainting



**DO NOT** sit the patient on a chair with  
their head between their knees.

1. Follow DRSABCD.
2. Lie the patient down on their back with their legs elevated.
3. Loosen any tight clothing.
4. Ensure plenty of fresh air – open a window if possible.
5. Treat any injury resulting from a fall.
6. If fainting is the result of an underlying medical condition, advise the patient to seek medical aid.
